Shaoxiong Chen is a professor at the Department of Pathology, Indiana University School of Medicine. He is dedicated to serving CAPA, has been a lifetime CAPA member and actively involved in CAPA activities. He was a co-chair of the Award committee (March 2019 to Feb 2020) and a chair (March 2020 to Feb 2021) of the award committee. From March 2021 to Feb 2022, he served the chair of CAPA education committee, added 9 additional educational subcommittees by working with CAPA

president, Marilyn and organized multiple educational meetings/courses. Subcommittee change has significantly benefited CAPA future education activities/courses. From March 2020 to Feb 2022, he was also a CAPA BOD member. From March 2023 to now, he has been serving a CAPA EC member. Shaoxiong Chen would like to continue his participation in CAPA various activities and try his best to make CAPA a better and stronger pathology organization.

At the state level, Shaoxiong Chen was appointed as a CME chair of Indiana Association of Pathologists (IAP) from 2015 to 2017. Later, he was the president of IAP (2019-2020) and played a pivotal role in restructuring and reorganizing the association in line with the future needs.

In addition to his clinical work and leadership roles, he has published over 60 peer reviewed articles and some book chapters including WHO blue book. He has been giving lectures at national and international meetings including USCAP, ASC, etc.
